Overview

What is the Web Empowered Church?

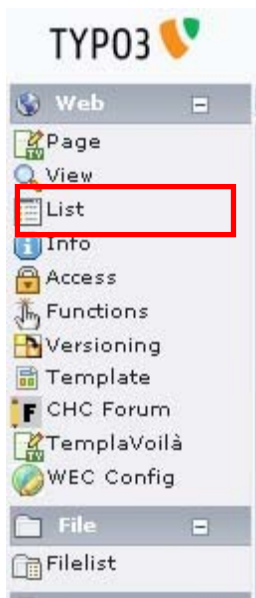


Part I – Installing the Default Template Setup:

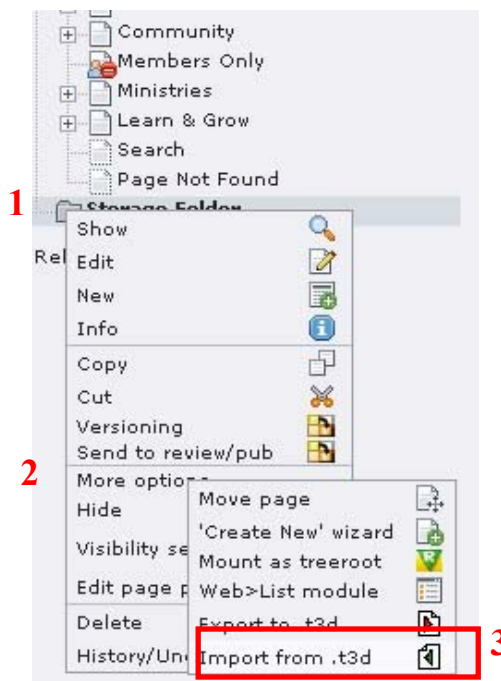
NOTE: If you are currently using the Web Empowered Church software, you do not need to worry about downloading the Default Template Setup as it is already included – you can skip to part 2.

If you are not using Web Empowered Church, but another version of Typo3, you will need to download this Default Template Setup first.

1. Download the file “**defaultsetup.t3d**”
2. Select **Save to Disk**.
3. Next, log into your WEC Typo3 website with full admin account and select **List** in the left column.



4. Click on the folder icon for the Storage Folder (1).

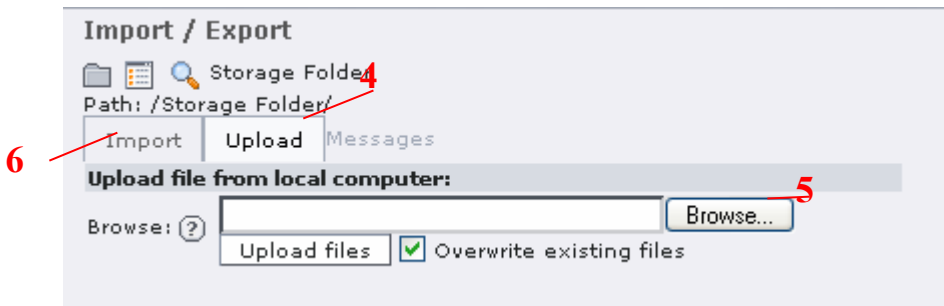

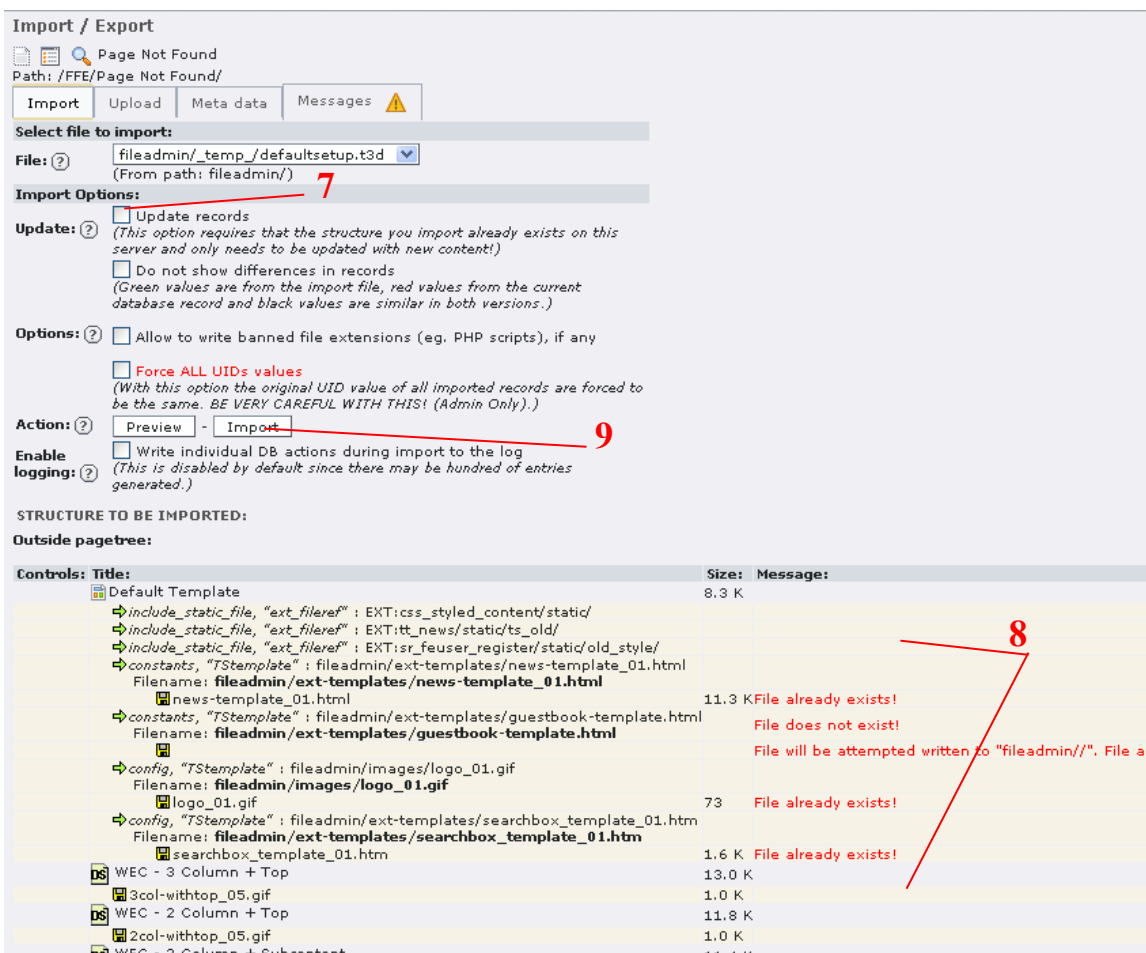
5. From the popup menu, select More Options (2), then Import from T3d (3).



6. Select the Upload tab (4) and Browse (5) to find your **defaultsetup.t3d** file (remember where you saved it earlier). Click the **Upload files** button.



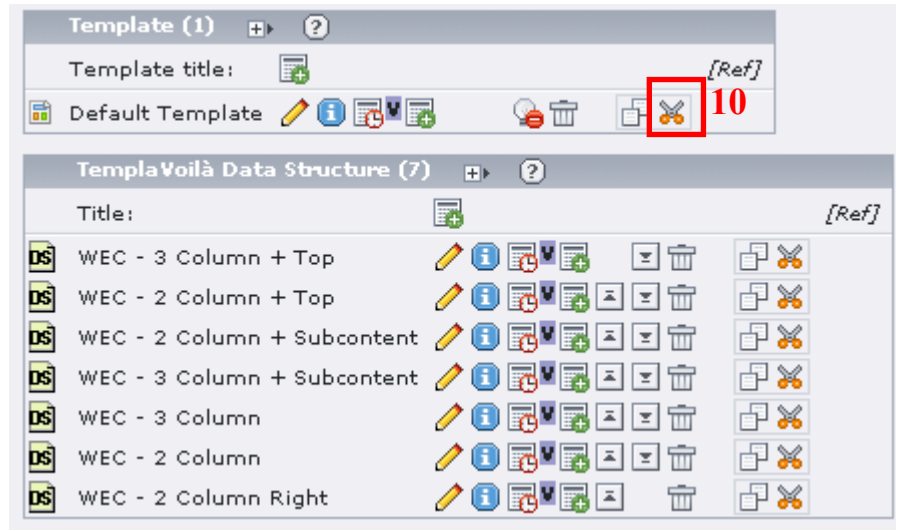
7. Once the file has uploaded, click the **Import** tab (6). You will see a screen similar to this (Note: if you are UPDATING the Default Template Setup, check the Update records (7) box. Otherwise, if it's the first time you've installed, just leave blank)



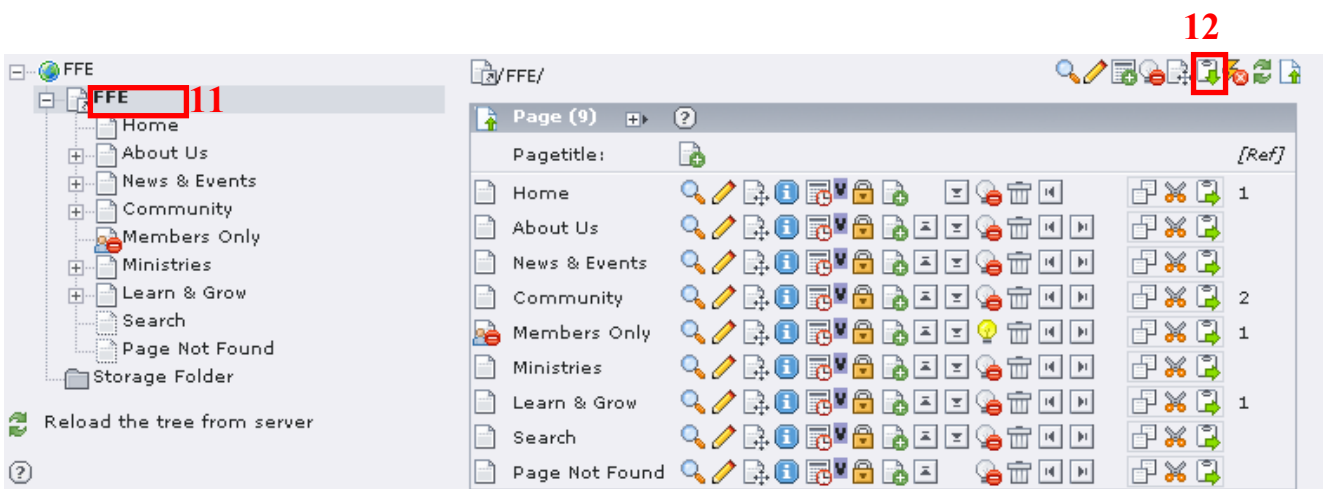
8. If you see messages that the file already exists, chance are, you already have the Default Template setup installed. Otherwise, if there are no other messages (8) you can click the **Import** button (9).
9. After the setup has imported. Click on List in the left column.



- You'll see the TemplaVoila Data Structure as well as a Default Template (typoscript). Cut the Default Template (10) from the page.



- Still in List view, click on your top-level page (usually right above the Home page) (11) and paste the Default Template by clicking the white clipboard icon (12) at the top of the page.



Part II – Installing the Template Series:

Cascades of Life Template Series

Each Template Series is made up of two parts, the files and images that create the design of the template (1), and the Web Empowered Church (WEC) Typo3 Template element (2).

A 2 Column TemplaVoila template. Includes blue, brown, gray, and green color-schemes.

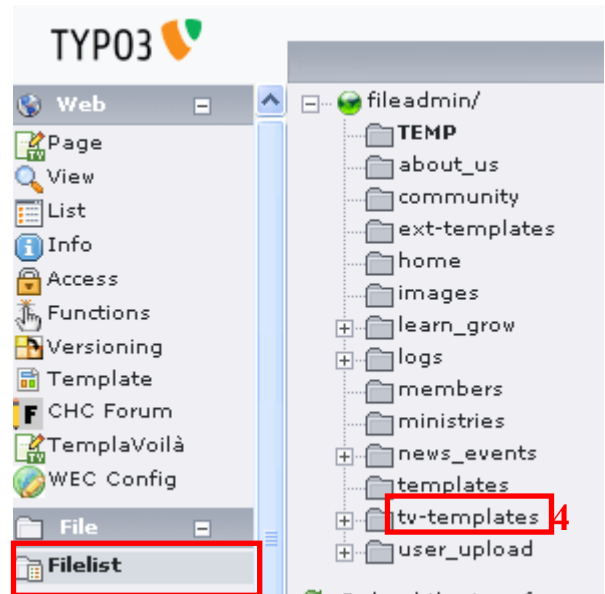

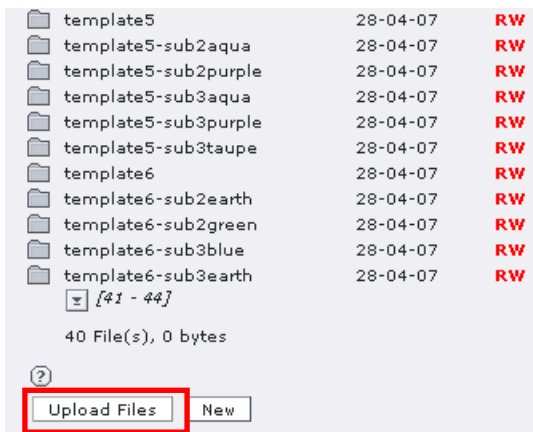
- Download each of these files and save them to your computer.



- Next, log into your WEC Typo3 website and click on Filelist (3). Once the File tree loads, click on the tv-templates folder name (4).

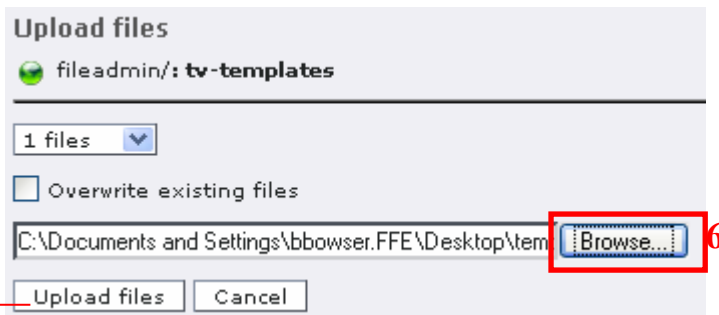


- When the list of files/folder load, click on the Upload Files button at the bottom of the list (5).

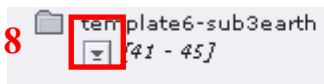

- Click the Browse Button (6) to select the .zip file that you downloaded earlier. Click the Upload files button (7).



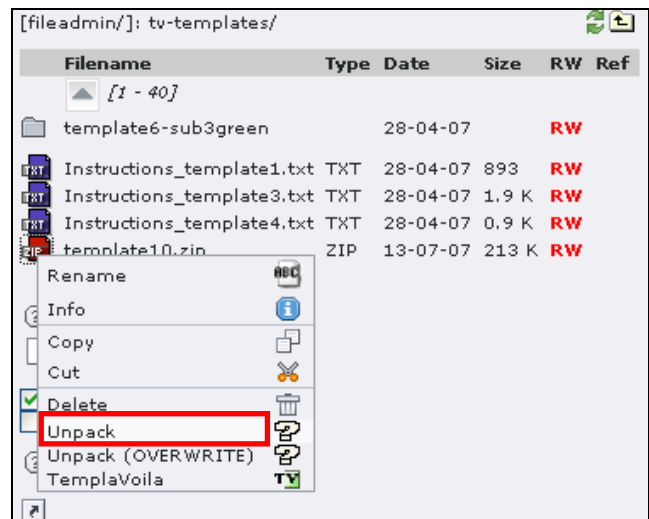
- Your zip fill will now be included in the list of files/folders in the tv-templates folder. You may need to scroll down in the list and click the more arrow (8)



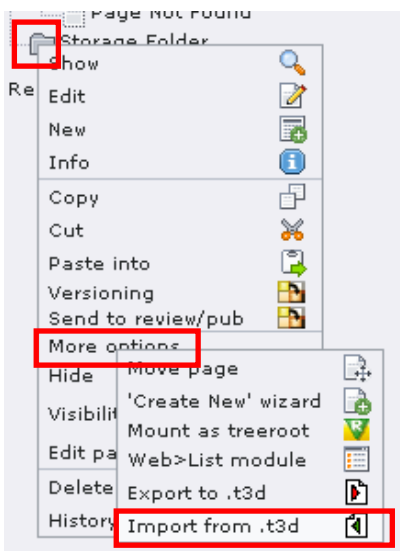
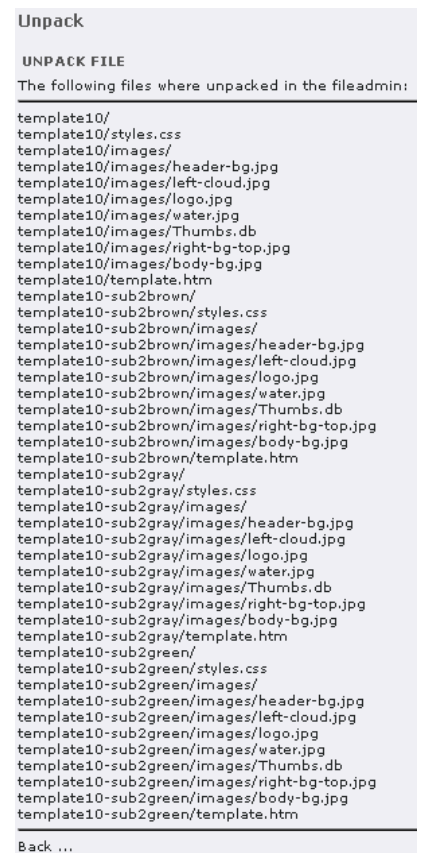

- Click on the icon of the zip file and select **Unpack** from the popup menu.



- A list of all the files will be shown. If you see this list, you were successful in importing the first half of the template series.
- Next, you will need to import the WEC Typo3 template elements for the series.
- Click on List in the left menu.
- Click on the **Storage Folder** icon, select **More options**, then **Import from .t3d**.

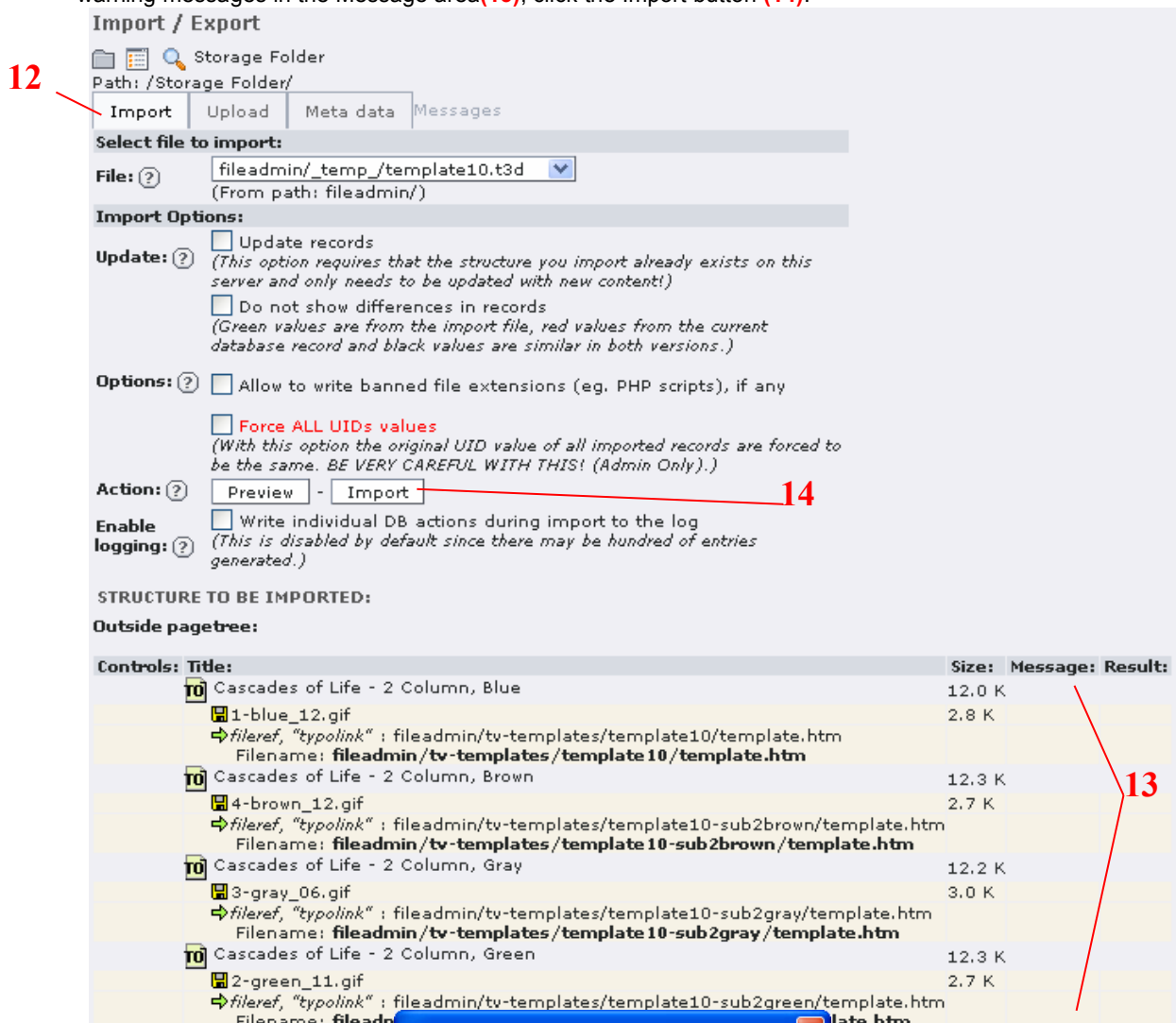


- Click on the Upload tab (9) at the top of the screen, then click the Browse button (10) to select the template .t3d file from your computer (remember where you downloaded it).



- Click the Upload files button (11).

- Select the Import (12) tab at the top, you should now see a list of "TO" elements to import. If you do not see any red warning messages in the Message area (13), click the Import button (14).

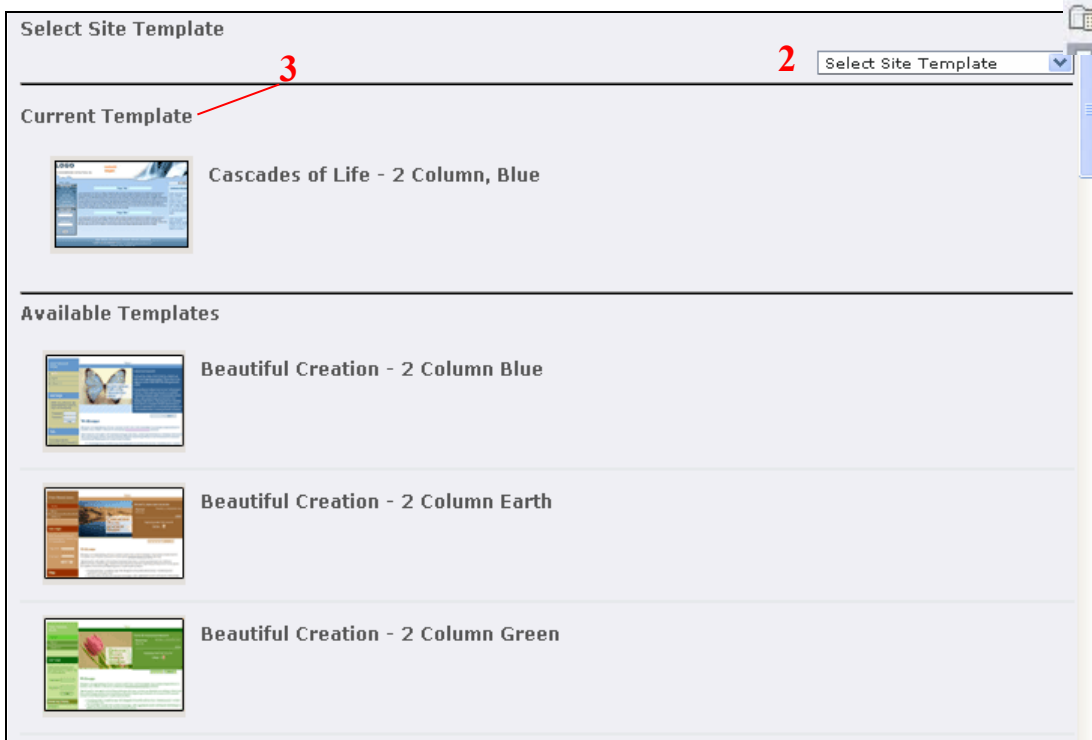
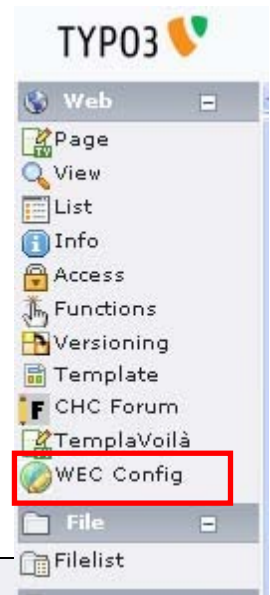


- Click OK when prompted



Part III – Apply the New Template

1. To apply a template from the series you just imported, click on **WEC Config (1)** and from the selector box in the top right corner make sure you have **Select Site Template (2)**.
2. Click on the template you wish to use for your site – it will appear under the **Current Template** heading (3)



3. Click the **Clear FE cache** link in the left menu under Admin functions to be sure to refresh your website.
